Definition: *joint-heirs* – a fellow heir; one who obtains something assigned to himself with others

"This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. 17 For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. 18 But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law." (Galatians 5:16-18)

B. The Holy Spirit _____

"These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you. 26 But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." (John 14:25-26)

"And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father." (Galatians 4:6)

"Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need." (Hebrews 4:16)

ASSURANCE FROM THE SPIRIT

Definition: beareth witness – to give evidence

"Who are kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. (1 Peter 1:5)
