**Definition:** *pure* – free from corrupt desire or any mixture of what is false; blameless

**Definition:** *conscience* – moral perception

*“If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me: 19 But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer.” (Psalm 66:18-19)*

A FAITHFUL CONSISTENCY

**Definition:** *without ceasing* – continual; permanent

**Definition:** *remembrance* – making mention of someone; memory, recollection

*“For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers;” (Romans 1:9)*
